04 - Lift Arm

Remove and Install

5. Disconnect the ram hoses.
6. Support the lift arm with suitable lifting equipment.
7. Remove the bolt and washer from the front end of the cylinder rod.
8. Use a suitable hammer and drift to remove the cylinder rod from the cylinder body.
9. Remove the bolt and washer from the rear end of the cylinder rod.
10. Use a suitable hammer and drift to remove the cylinder rod from the cylinder body.
11. Remove the cylinder rod from the cylinder body.
12. Inspect the condition of the hoses and seals at this stage.
13. Replace worn or damaged hoses and seals as required.
14. Reassemble the ram and support with suitable lifting equipment.





